About

The Junior Engine Officer assists with all Engine Room duties, such as operating and maintaining the propulsion plants and support systems - and must learn the procedures for operating/overhauling equipment and understanding engine room watch-keeping in order to become a competent officer able to function independently.

The above duties demand a very good standard of English, and the VIRSEC Maritime English Test for Junior Engineering Officers is designed to assist Ship Operators and employers make recruiting and training decisions by assessing the English language understanding and skills of crew in this role.

Test Duration

The user must attempt the test in 90 minutes, and in one sitting. Candidates will be timed as they tackle the questions, to simulate exam conditions and must achieve a minimum score of 70% to pass.

Note: If a candidate does not answer all of the questions by the time the timer runs out, they will fail those unanswered questions. Test delegates will be allowed a second attempt at the test for free should they not succeed the first time. If they fail a second attempt, the test will have to be re-purchased.

Target Audience

The VIRSEC Maritime English Test for Junior Engine Officers is designed to assess candidates' English language competence between the levels of 'Lower Intermediate' and 'Intermediate' (CEFR (Europe): B1 to B2 and ILR (United States): Level 1+ to 2+).

A candidate at these levels will be able to understand and produce frequently used expressions relating to areas of most immediate relevance to the function of a Junior Engine Officer onboard ship. This corresponds to the STCW Maritime Functional Areas below:

- Maritime Engineering
- Electrical Engineering
- Ship Repair & Maintenance
- Ship Operations, Crew & Passengers

Regulations

The English Tests are designed from the ground up using approved guidelines from the International Maritime Organisation (IMO Model English Course 3.17); IMO Standard Marine Communication Phrases (SMCPs); and consistent with the functional framework set out by the Standards of Training, Certification and Watchkeeping (STCW).
