About

The Proficiency as Ship Security Officer [SSO] Course, also referred to a Vessel Security Officer [VSO] is a mandatory training requirement under STCW ISPS for members of a Ship's Crew fulfilling the role of Ship Security Officer appointed by the Shipping Company.

The course teaches the learner to ensure both the security of the ship, as well as the implementation and support of the Ship Security Plan. This course has been specifically tailored for potential Ship Security Officers for Superyachts, Mega Yachts & Motor Yachts.

Target Audience

The course is aimed at those seeking a certificate of proficiency as a Ship Security compliant with Chapter XI-2 of the annex to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) 1974, as amended and the International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code.

Course Duration

The Ship Security Officer [SSO] Course duration is approximately 21 hours in duration. A slight variation is allowed for individual reading speeds, but this minimum must be met in order to successfully pass this course.

Awarding Body

The Ship Security Officer [SSO] Course is fully Approved under the UK Department for Transport Maritime & Coastguard Agency [MCA] and meets with STCW Reg VI/5. paragraph 1 and Section A-VI/5, paragraphs 1 to 4 of the STCW Convention and Code 1978, as amended.
